ATTENTION ALL EXHIBITORS!

- **Displays:** Artists/Crafters should provide their own display devices/setup, tables, chairs, tents, etc. *See info about renting PopUp Displays (limited supply.)* Artists and Crafters must stay until 3 p.m. closing and *are welcome to stay all evening during June Jam.*
- **All work must be that of the exhibitor.** Fine Artist's work is eligible for only ONE AWARD in each category. Cash and prizes available: Best of Show - \$200; 1st place - \$150; 2nd place - \$100; 3rd place - \$75. *Judge may award any place to an entry based on merit, and if, in the opinion of the judge, none of the entries in a category meet the standards of excellence, no award will be given. See other side for Sugar Show information.*
- **Student Art:** High school/College student art work will be judged for 1st place - \$25. No registration fee is charged; however, *rental fee on popup displays (limited supply) are \$10 each for all requesting them.*
- **Artists must be in attendance for work to be judged.**

Publicity: Please mail articles and photos of work to be exhibited (these will be used for newspaper publicity) as soon as possible, and **no later than May 13** to mailing address above. Email info and print quality images to the email provided above.

ATTENTION FINE ARTISTS & CRAFTERS

Exhibitor's Fees: \$25.00 entry fee (or \$50 for late fee) for an approximate 12' x 12' space (*No entry fee for MS/HS/college students.*) Additional spaces are \$15.00 each. If you'd like to be assigned a spot next to a friend, please let us know, and we'll try to accommodate. Exhibitors must bring own display devices/tents, tables, etc. **EXCEPTION:** *Renting a Nescatunga PopUp Display - each at \$10 per unit. Limited supply. Must register early.* Framework and tents may be set up Friday from 7:00 to 8:00 p.m., and Saturday after 7:00 a.m. Security will NOT be provided. **The Nescatunga Arts and Humanities Council is not responsible for personal injury or damages/loss of items.**

Registration: Early registration is encouraged. Registered fine art and craft exhibitors will be located on the north side of the Courthouse lawn. **Friday Evening or Festival Day:** Upon arrival, check in at the registration desk to find out where you have been assigned. The registration desk will be open Friday from 7:00 to 8:00 p.m. and Saturday from 7:00-10:00 a.m. Exhibitors must occupy booth until 3:00 p.m. closing and *are welcome to stay longer throughout the evening's June Jam.*

Parking: On-site parking is available for registration and unloading only. Parking during the festival is provided two blocks east of exhibit area on Barnes Street. Assistance is available to set up upon request.

Food: Hospitality table for exhibitors 7:00-9:00 a.m. During the morning festival hours (9:00 a.m. - 11:00 a.m.) a food booth with breakfast foods will be available as a Nescatunga fundraiser. Booths selling "gourmet foods" of special baked items and water will be available until sold out. Food Trucks for the June Jam will set up around 11 a.m. for the rest of the day.

NEW: Sugar Show. Three Categories -- Decorated Cakes, Decorated Cupcakes and Decorated Cookies. Decorated cakes should have AT LEAST two tiers. There should be no less than one dozen cookies/cupcakes. Contest takes place in the Extreme Building (southwest corner of square). Setup of table display must be completed prior to 9 a.m. judging. Contestants may enter ONE item in each category. Entry fee is \$10 per category (\$20 for late entries) or free to MS/HS/College students. One first place prize in each category, plus a People's Choice Award based on appearance. Prizes: \$50 for first place in Professional and Aspiring Divisions and \$10 prize for first place student entry in each of the three categories. More info at www.nescatunga.org/sugar-show.

Weather: In the event of inclement weather, the exhibition area and Sugar Show will be moved to 4 Generations Organic building, south of Alva at 2878 College Blvd. The Quilt Show will remain inside the Woods County Courthouse.
